



Have questions about being an AMC Transfer Student?

How many transfer credits will Anna Maria College accept from other institutions?

Anna Maria College will accept up to 60 transfer credits which is equivalent to two full years of college coursework. Additionally, AMC will accept all credits from any student entering with an associate's degree.

What constitutes a transfer student?

Twelve or more transfer credits which is equivalent to approximately one semester or more of college level study qualifies as a transfer student.

What type of academic support is available for transfer students?

Anna Maria students are all assigned individual academic advisors based on their primary area of study. Advisors guide students in course selection, internships, study abroad, and more. AMC also offers a fully-staffed Learning Center open to all students at no extra charge.

Do I need to send in a transfer application if I have previously applied to Anna Maria College?

No, if you have applied in the past two years, simply send the admissions office a short note or email saying that you would like to reactivate your previous application to the college and submit the additional information detailed above.

What types of financial aid and scholarships are available for transfer students?

All transfer students are eligible for a \$7500 yearly transfer merit scholarship.

Can transfers live on campus? Is housing guaranteed?

Transfer students can live on campus; housing is assigned on a space available basis.

How are transfer students assigned roommates?

Transfer students are assigned roommates based on availability.

What criteria does the Admissions Office use to evaluate transfer applicants for admission?

Admission to Anna Maria as a transfer student is based mainly on academic achievement as seen both in the high school record and the college transcript. All students are evaluated on an individual basis with concern given to individual situations and circumstances. Emphasis is placed on the college record.

What if I did not do well in high school but have now improved academically in my college course work?

Anna Maria looks for patterns of improvement in the academic record. We understand that students often experience difficult periods, and we do take improvement over time into consideration when evaluating applications for admission.

How does Anna Maria College award transfer credits? When will I receive my Transfer Credit Evaluation?

Anna Maria generally grants transfer credit for courses in which the student has received a C or better (please see above for explanation). If you are accepted to Anna Maria College as a transfer student, you may request a preliminary transfer credit evaluation.

How is class standing determined?

Class standing is determined based on the number of transfer credits you are awarded. The credit breakdown for class standing is listed above.
