Students who have completed an Associate degree or higher do not need to submit high school transcripts

COLLEGE TRANSCRIPT: Submit official transcripts (in sealed envelope with official college stamp) of all colleges previously attended.

STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES: High School applicants must submit SAT, ACT or TOEFL scores. Transfers that have been out of high school for fewer than three years must submit the SAT or ACT test scores.

Application Deadlines

Fall Semester

Admission to the College is offered on a rolling basis. Students are encouraged to submit their application before March 1st to ensure availability of financial aid and on-campus housing. Once the applicant's file is complete, the Admissions Committee notifies applicants within two to three weeks with a decision.

Spring Semester

Students who are applying for admission for the Spring Semester are also reviewed on a rolling basis. Students are encouraged to submit their application materials by December 1st to ensure availability of financial aid and on-campus housing.

Campus Visits

Anna Maria College believes that it is very important for prospective students and their families to visit its campus and meet with staff as part of the college selection process. During the weeks ahead, we strongly encourage students to contact the Office of Admissions to schedule a campus tour. Campus tours are given Monday through Friday. Please call ahead so we can schedule an appointment for you at 508-849-3360. We will also offer Saturday tour dates on selected days during the 2008-2009 academic year. Processing of the FAFSA takes two to three weeks. Our priority FAFSA deadline is March 1st.
