



Art Portfolio Requirements

In addition to applying to the college, a student requesting admission into the art program must submit a portfolio of their artwork. The portfolio should consist of 10-15 pieces, which reflect a cross-section of the applicant's artistic training as well as the student's creative ability.

Work in the following media is suggested:



Drawing



Watercolor



Design (2-D & 3-D)



Printmaking



Pottery/Sculpture



Pastel



Photography



Computer Graphics



Oil Painting



Mixed Media

Of the above, drawing skills are emphasized because of the importance of these skills as a foundation to the other art media.
