Freshman Applicant Procedures and Checklist

- APPLICATION FORM:** Complete the application form and mail it to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions, Anna Maria College, 50 Sunset Lane, Box O, Paxton, MA 01612
- \$40 APPLICATION FEE:** A nonrefundable \$40 application fee. Make check payable to Anna Maria College. Fee is waived for applications submitted online at www.annamaria.edu/admissions.
- OFFICIAL HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT:** You will need to submit an official high school transcript (with official high school stamp) including first quarter Senior grades, or a copy of a high school equivalency diploma (GED).
- STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES:** Applicants must take either the SAT, ACT or TOEFL and submit the results.

Music and Art Applicants (in addition to the steps above)

- AUDITION OR PORTFOLIO REVIEW:** If you are applying for admission to any music program, you must complete an audition as part of the application process. If you are applying for admission to any art program, you must complete a portfolio review as part of the application process. Call the Office of Fine Arts at (508) 849-3450 to schedule your appointment.

Transfer Applicant Procedures and Checklist

- APPLICATION FORM:** Complete the application form and mail it to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions, Anna Maria College, 50 Sunset Lane, Box O, Paxton, MA 01612
- \$40 APPLICATION FEE:** A non-refundable \$40 application fee. Make check payable to Anna Maria College. Fee is waived for applications submitted online at www.annamaria.edu/admissions.
- OFFICIAL HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT:** Applicants who have been out of high school for fewer than three years will need to submit an official high school transcript (with official high school stamp) listing all courses and date of graduation.
- COLLEGE TRANSCRIPT:** Submit official transcripts (in sealed envelope with official college stamp) of all colleges previously attended.
- STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES:** Applicants who have been out of high school for fewer than three years must take either the SAT, ACT or TOEFL and submit the results.

Nursing Applicant Procedures and Checklist

- APPLICATION FORM:** Complete the application form and mail it to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions, Anna Maria College, 50 Sunset Lane, Box O, Paxton, MA 01612
- \$40 APPLICATION FEE:** A nonrefundable \$40 application fee. Make check payable to Anna Maria College. Fee is waived for applications submitted online at www.annamaria.edu/admissions.
- OFFICIAL HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT:** You will need to submit an official high school transcript (with official high school stamp) including first quarter Senior grades, or a copy of a high school equivalency diploma (GED). Transfer applicants, please provide proof of high school graduation or a copy of a high school equivalency diploma (GED). Students who have completed an Associate degree or higher do not need to submit high school transcripts
- COLLEGE TRANSCRIPT:** Submit official transcripts (in sealed envelope with official college stamp) of all colleges previously attended.
- STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES:** High School applicants must submit SAT, ACT or TOEFL scores. Transfers that have been out of high school for fewer than three years must submit the SAT or ACT test scores.
- ESSAY:** All Nursing Applicants must complete the essay. Your essay should be 250 to 500 words.
Topic: Why do you want to become a nurse?
- LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION:** One letter of recommendation, preferably from a teacher or counselor, must be submitted.
- TEST OF ESSENTIAL ACADEMIC SKILLS (TEAS):** Given by the College with a \$57 testing fee. For more information and to register for the TEAS exam visit www.annamaria.edu/admissions.

Application Deadlines

Fall Semester

Admission to the College is offered on a rolling basis. Students are encouraged to submit their application before March 1st to ensure availability of financial aid and on-campus housing. Once the applicant's file is complete, the Admissions Committee notifies applicants within two to three weeks with a decision.

Spring Semester

Students who are applying for admission for the Spring Semester are also reviewed on a rolling basis. Students are encouraged to submit their application materials by December 1st to ensure availability of financial aid and on-campus housing.

Campus Visits

Anna Maria College believes that it is very important for prospective students and their families to visit its campus and meet with staff as part of the college selection process. During the weeks ahead, we strongly encourage students to contact the Office of Admissions to schedule a campus tour. Campus tours are given Monday through Friday. Please call ahead so we can schedule an appointment for you at 508-849-3360. We will also offer Saturday tour dates on selected days during the 2008-2009 academic year. All applicants for financial aid must submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), which is available online at www.fafsa.ed.gov or by contacting the Federal Student Aid Hotline at 1-800-4FEDAID. In order for AMC to receive your FAFSA, you will need to include our school code (002117). Applicants are encouraged to submit their FAFSA as soon after January 1st as possible. Processing of the FAFSA takes two to three weeks. Our priority FAFSA deadline is March 1st.
