### MUSIC AND ART APPLICANTS (IN ADDITION TO THE STEPS ABOVE)

- AUDITION OR PORTFOLIO REVIEW: If you are applying for admission to any music program, you must complete an audition. If you are applying for admission to any art program, you must submit a portfolio for review. ## Application Deadlines

### *Fall Semester*

Students are encouraged to submit their application by March 1 to ensure availability of financial aid and on-campus housing, if desired. The review of completed applications will typically begin by the end of November. Decisions usually are sent out within 3 to 4 weeks of an application's completion.

### *Spring Semester*

Students are encouraged to submit their application by December 1 to ensure availability of financial aid and on-campus housing, if desired. The review of completed applications for spring enrollment typically begins around October 1.

## Campus Visits

We believe that it is very important for prospective students and their families to visit the campus and meet with our students and staff as part of the college search. There are a number of opportunities for students to visit Anna Maria. Campus tours are offered daily at 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. Additionally, the College hosts open houses in the fall and general information sessions on selected Saturdays, both in fall and spring. During the summer, information sessions are offered on most Wednesdays at 11 a.m. To learn about specific dates or to register for a visit, go to [www.annamaria.edu/visit](http://www.annamaria.edu/visit). ## Financial Aid

Financial assistance in the form of grants, scholarships, loans, employment and payment plans are available through Anna Maria College's Financial Aid Office. The Financial Aid staff helps students make informed financial decisions about college. All applicants for financial aid must submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), which is available online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) or by contacting the Federal Student Aid Hotline at 1-800-4FEDAID. In order for AMC to receive your FAFSA, you will need to include our school code (002117). Applicants are encouraged to submit their FAFSA as soon after January 1 as possible. Processing of the FAFSA takes two to three weeks. Our priority FAFSA deadline is March 1.
