



## MAY 2018 RECENT GRADUATES SURVEY

### Key Findings:

- 92% of the May 2018 undergraduate alumni surveyed were employed or pursuing further education.
- 67% of the May 2018 undergraduate alumni surveyed were employed after graduation.
- 25% of May 2018 undergraduate alumni surveyed are pursuing further education after graduation.



### THE SURVEY

In May 2018, 118 traditional undergraduate alumni who had earned their degrees were asked to participate in an online survey about their employment and educational activities since graduation. Undergraduate alumni were asked to participate in the survey through a series of three email communications (an invitation, and two reminders). Overall, 85 undergraduate alumni responded to the survey, a response rate of 72%. This brief details the principal findings from the survey. Responses are based on the number of alumni responding to the relevant survey items.

### EMPLOYMENT OUTCOMES: UNDERGRADUATE ALUMNI

- The majority of those employed (90%) were working full-time.
- 84% of the May 2018 undergraduate alumni who were employed indicated that their job was “somewhat” or “highly related” to their major/program.
- Among May 2018 undergraduate degree alumni who were employed, 91% were working in Massachusetts.
- The average annual reported gross salary for May 2018 undergraduate alumni working full-time was \$ 51,025 (median: \$ 55,000).

## EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES: UNDERGRADUATE ALUMNI

- 25% of the May 2018 undergraduate alumni were pursuing an advanced degree at a graduate or professional school after graduation.
- The majority (96%) of those engaged in further education were pursuing some type of Master's degree (MPA, MSW, MS, MA or other Master's degree).



### Degree fields of May 2018 Undergraduate alumni who were pursuing further education included:

- Sixty-seven percent of the May 2018 undergraduate alumni participated in at least one internship, clinical experience, or field experience, practicum or else in service learning.
- Ninety-four percent of the undergraduate alumni indicated that they were satisfied overall with their educational experience at Anna Maria College.
- Ninety-six percent of the undergraduate alumni indicated that the learning resources and technology at Anna Maria College to be current, comprehensive and easily accessible.
